Yellow Shoe Crew Volunteer Program

The Ronald McDonald House Charities® of West Georgia Yellow Shoe Crew is a group of teens with the collective goal to help make a difference in the lives of critically ill or injured children and their families who are receiving medical care at a nearby facility.

As stewards of the Ronald McDonald House, the Yellow Shoe Crew works to advocate, fundraise, and raise community awareness about the programs and services provided by RMHC® including the Ronald McDonald House and the Ronald McDonald House Family Room.

The Yellow Shoe Crew consists of community teenagers who have demonstrated excellence in leadership and community service. Members participate in bi-monthly meetings, fundraising events, volunteering opportunities, community outreach and work on projects, community projects, and other opportunities as defined by RMHC staff.

Yellow Shoe Crew members must be able to guarantee a commitment of one year of service from August 2018-August 2019.

Candidates beginning their freshman or sophomore of high school must commit to a minimum of 25 service hours within their membership year.

Candidates beginning their junior or senior year of high school must commit to a minimum of 40 service hours within their membership year.

We ask that each applicant carefully considers whether they can commit to the attendance and service hour requirements.

All Yellow Shoe Crew members must obtain permission from their parent/guardian prior to accepting any service obligations.

Yearly dues of 20.00 must be payed after interview for your application to be accepted. This will cover the cost of tshirt, badge and lanyard.

Teens will be selected through an application and interview process.



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Application Process for the Yellow Shoe Crew

The Application Packet must be submitted at one time (*applications missing ANY of the below information will not be considered*).

After all the forms are returned, we will email you to schedule a personal interview if we deem this necessary based on number of applications received. Applicants will be notified the week following the date of their submitted application.

Once you have been accepted into the program the next step will be to attend a **mandatory** orientation and one training session (to be scheduled after your orientation).

Application Packets must include:

- Online Application
- Photo of Teen
- Essay Questions
- Completed Reference Form– reference must (no exceptions):
 - a. Be non-relatives of teen applicant
 - b. Have known applicant for 2+ years
 - c. Be 18-years-old or older
- Teen and Parent Service Commitment Form
